



INVENTIONS & PATENT POLICY

The University has in place an Inventions and Patent Policy. Under the terms of this policy, inventions, which include all devices, products, processes, methods, technologies, discoveries or intellectual property rights of any kind whatsoever, whether complete or incomplete, arising in the course of research and/or other work associated with the University, are vested in the University. Inventions developed by staff and/or students of the University must be reported by such staff and/or students to the Director of Commercialisation, by the completion of an Invention Disclosure Form which is available on request from the Commercialisation Office.

It is of prime importance that the integrity and confidentiality of inventions are strictly maintained. Staff and/or students are, therefore, required to take all reasonable steps to ensure that inventions, whether complete or incomplete, are not disclosed in such a way as to destroy confidentiality. Staff and students of the University are bound by the terms of the Inventions and Patent Policy.
